Summer Hosts,

Our Club had 4 Community projects in August. On the 3rd we delivered 40 back packs to the Progressive Baptist Church after their urgent request for help to aid in their back to school program. On the 9th we delivered 10 cases (240 bottles) of water to Mesa Fire Department for their hydration program. On the 17th we presented the LCI Peace Poster information to Franklin Brimhall Art teacher, Laura Miller, who is making it a class project. Lastly, on the 29th Lions Webster, Hackney and Worbington took food to the Ronald McDonald Cambridge House and fed 12 families. We left plenty of food for any late comers.

District Governor Carolyn J. White held her 21C District 'Kick Off' meeting on the 4th. The sessions about zone chairs, tail twisting, protocol and fund raising were very informational. At the District Council meeting all questions and concerns were addressed. Mesa Host was well represented with Lions Hackney, Webster, Thresher, Hill, Johnson-Book and Worbington. We were given the task of running a 50/50 raffle and sold \$740 worth. Our Club shared in the profits and after bills paid received \$198 and had fun doing it.
